### **Update on all litigations between a litigant and Fondul Proprietatea SA**

Franklin Templeton Investment Management Ltd. United Kingdom Bucharest Branch (“**the Fund Manager**”), in its capacity as sole administrator and fund manager of Fondul Proprietatea SA (“**the Fund**”), would like to update shareholders and investors on all ongoing cases between Ioana Sfiraiala (**the “Litigant”**) and the Fund, as set out in the table enclosed as Annex 1 to this report.

In particular, the Fund Manager would like to note that the Bucharest Court of Appeal announced on 25 February 2015 that it has admitted the Fund’s appeal in file no. 8541/3/2012 regarding the Litigant’s annulment action against certain Shareholders’ Resolutions of 23 November 2012, as set out in Annex 2 herein.

The decision of the Bucharest Court of Appeal is final and sets the validity of the challenged resolutions.
